Tricia Waddell adds a decorative touch to any straight seam by using a flat fell seam finish with grosgrain ribbon and topstitching.





Supplies

- 7/8" wide grosgrain ribbon
- Matching or contrasting thread for edgestitching/topstitching
- Seam ruler

Notes:

• The finished flat fell seam is a 5/8" seam allowance, so make sure to choose a ribbon width that is wider than 5/8" so that you see it peek out from the seam.

Instructions

1. With wrong sides together, sew a seam with 3/4" seam allowance.

- 2. Press the seam allowances towards the back of the garment or project.
- 3. Trim the bottom seam allowance to 1/8".
- 4. Press the top seam allowance over 1/8" to fold over and enclose the bottom seam allowance. Press flat towards the back of the garment.
- 5. Insert the ribbon underneath the seam allowances, against the seamline. Pin in place.
- 6. Edgestitch along the seam allowance, securing the seam allowance and ribbon to the base fabric.

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
