The Concealed Zipper Foot makes sewing this type of zipper foolproof!









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Perfect for travel, this clutch purse stores flat in your briefcase or easily packs in your luggage so you're ready for a stylish evening out. Clutch purse coordinates with the embroidered dress featured on this show. Pair these together for a special occasion. You'll feel stylish, comfortable, and well dressed!

Options, Ideas and Notes:

- This purse was originally featured as a <u>Foot of the Month Project</u> for Brother Sewing Machine Company. <u>CLICK HERE</u> to download instructions for the **Clutch Purse with Concealed Zipper**. You'll find step-by-step directions to make your own purse using simple measurements. In these instructions you'll also learn how to install a *concealed* or *invisible style* zipper using a foot designed specifically for this task. Check with your local sewing machine dealer to find a similar foot for your machine model.
- Select a <u>Coats Polyester Invisible Zipper</u> with a zipper pull color that closely matches your fabric.
- The purse and dress are both made from dupioni silk. As an alternative most any medium weight fabric will work just fine. Consider suiting, sportswear, and even denim for a more casual look. With or without embroidery, this is a great looking dress.
- Featured pattern is Simplicity 1249. This is a classic style! With flattering princess seams, this pattern includes multiple opportunities for perfecting fit. I loved the pattern and plan to use it again! To perfect the fit, make a trial garment from inexpensive fabric in a similar weight. This is especially important if you are going to invest in the silk and add embroidery. If this pattern is unavailable look for a similar dress pattern with princess seams.
