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Your next statement piece of jewelry is as close as your embroidery machine! With the right design it's easy to make lace jewelry with little more than stabilizer and thread.



Materials and supplies featured in this segment:

- Featured machine is the Brother XV8550D Dream Machine2
- Lace jewelry designs are included in <u>SAEU1</u> the Brother 3D Lace Embellishment Embroidery Design Collection. This USB design collection is available from your local Brother dealer. Visit <u>brother-usa.com</u> for more information.
- Brother <u>SA540</u> fibrous water-soluble stabilizer is used for stitching free-standing jewelry designs. These designs are meant to be used with standard polyester embroidery thread.
- Optional Hot fix tool and hot fix rhinestones for embellishment.

Tips for Embroidering Lace Jewelry:

Wind one or more bobbins to match your top embroidery thread. Tightly hoop two layers of the stabilizer in your hoop. Start with a new embroidery needle and embroider design using a slow speed if you have the option. Trim away excess stabilizer and then dip in hot water to dissolve the rest. To thoroughly wash out stabilizer I like to rinse pieces in a solution consisting of ½ cup of liquid fabric softener dissolved in one gallon of hot water. After rinsing, dry on a terry towel, and then press with a warm iron right on the surface of the towel. Add rhinestones or beads to add sparkle and shine to your jewelry. Enjoy!
