Scuba Knit Dress Sarah Gunn

Materials needed:

Stable knit

dress pattern - PATTERN: Vogue 9047
Coats and Clark Eloflex Stretch Thread
Pellon lightweight interfacing
ballpoint pins
scissors
press cloth
heat soluble marker
seam gauge or ruler

Instructions:

Neckline Steps

- 1. Attach front and back at shoulders finish shoulder seam allowance and press towards back
- 2. Basting stitch around neckline seam allowance
- 3. Turn inside of garment face-up and fold along threadline. Secure with ballpoint pins.
- 4. Continue pinning to assure no slipping at app ½ to ¼ intervals
- 5. Can be basted at this point before taking to the machine
- 6. Stitch around neckline I like to go slow & leave needle in down position
- 7. Remove pins and steam press with press cloth (pin holes will close) My press cloth of choice is silk organza
- 8. Place angled edge of your scissors against the seam and trim
- 9. Clean up any areas so all is trimmed evenly against the stitching

Hem Steps

- 1. Mark the hem on dress with heat soluble marker
- 2. Cut a 1" piece of lightweight fusible knit interfacing the circumference of hem
- 3. Apply top edge of the interfacing just below hemline. Can be serged at this point along the bottem edge of the interfacing but it is not necessary.
- 4. Pins from back to mark the hemline
- 5. Fold along the interfacing using the pins as your guide
- 6. Stitch
- 7. Trim with angled edge of scissor along stitching line the same way as the neckline

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
