Chevron Pin Cushion

Materials

(2) 4½" x 4½" pieced chevron blocks

(2) 4¹/₂" x 4¹/₂" squares of grey fabric for backing

7oz poly beads for stuffing

Hand needle and matching thread

5" x 9" rectangle of fusible fleece or scrap batting

Assembly

Note: all seams are stitched using a ¼" seam allowance unless otherwise indicated.

- 1. With right sides together, stitch pieced chevron blocks together to complete chevron pattern. Press seams in same direction.
- 2. Fuse 5" x 9" piece of fusible to wrong side of chevron unit. Quilt as desired. Trim away excess fleece. Depending on your quilting, your project may have shrunk slightly.
- 3. With right sides together, stitch the 4½" x 4½" grey squares together along one edge, leaving a 3" opening for turning. Press seams open.
- 4. With right sides together, layer chevron unit on top of backing centering the seams and trimming the backing to match the chevron unit if needed. Stitch completely around the unit.
- Using a small ruler, align the ¾" line at the corner and draw a line diagonally across the corner to create a blunted corner. Stitch on the line, reinforcing with backstitching. Trim the corners ¼"-¼" away from seam. Repeat for all four corners.
- 6. Turn pincushion right side out through center opening. Press flat.
- 7. Stuff with 7oz of poly beads. Using hand needle and matching thread, stitch opening closed by hand.

Note: if you decided to stitch the bonus units from making the chevron blocks, you can piece them together into a pinwheel unit and back them with a 3" square to make a small pin cushion for your short pins!
